



## FREON RECOVERY INFORMATION

The Clean Air Act of 1990 requires the recapture, recycling, and safe disposal of chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs) used in air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers as coolant. Under the Act, no one may accept an item containing CFCs and/or HCFCs for recycling or disposal unless the Freon contained within it is properly removed and the owner/hauler/appliance company can show proof of proper removal. It is also unlawful for any person to knowingly release or vent CFCs or HCFCs into the air.

**PECO** customers may currently recycle working refrigerators or freezers that are between 10 and 30 cubic feet in size. Size is usually indicated on the side of the refrigerator or freezer door. They will pick up for *free* and even send you a \$75.00 rebate. You can get an additional \$10.00 rebate for recycling a working air conditioner at the same time. They will, however, **not** come out for just an air conditioner.
